### TEF OUTCOME 1: SAVING LIVES ACHIEVEMENTS


 **22,991,246** acutely food-insecure people received food or cash assistance worth **\$325.8M**


 **112,874** families assisted with NFIs, emergency shelter and winterization


 **247,904** undocumented returnees received multi-sector assistance at 4 main border crossing points


 **217,291** teachers received cash incentives.

 **18,087,627** people accessed primary health care


 **1,170,191** pregnant and lactating women provided with malnutrition prevention packages


 **433,446** young people received information and counselling on health


 **52.88 km<sup>2</sup>** of safe land released from mines.


 **728,000** people reached with safe drinking water


### TEF OUTCOME 2: SAVING LIVELIHOODS ACHIEVEMENTS


 **18,788,509** individuals vaccinated against measles, polio, and COVID-19


 **928,115** children reached through school-feeding programmes


 **3,161** Medium/Small to Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) and informal businesses received investment funds


 **876** MSMEs received capacity building training in trade and business development.

 **12,677** jobs created or safeguarded


 **10,190,518** workdays and labour days generated


 **15,722** people benefitted from improved farm-based livelihood support


 **350** hectares of land brought under irrigation. **436** Common Interest Groups (CIGs) given agricultural education and technical support.


 **372** infrastructure constructed, rehabilitated or repaired.


### TEF OUTCOME 3: STRENGTHENING INSTITUTIONS ACHIEVEMENTS


 **6,283,552** people accessed safe drinking water

 **70** meetings held with rule of law stakeholders to promote access to justice for vulnerable groups

 **47,714** adolescents participated in life skills or comprehensive sexuality education interventions

 **27** high level policy meetings facilitated to elevate the voices of Afghan women leaders on Women, Peace and Security priorities

 **138,227** women and girls accessed safe spaces

 **153** Community-Based or Civil Society Organisations (CSO) trained on participatory and inclusive community planning
